

Beer Garden Coordinator (Volunteer)

The Canadian Ultimate Championships (CUC) 2019 will be held in Edmonton, Alberta, from August 11 to 18, 2019. Divisions of competition will include Juniors, Women, Open, Women's Masters and Open Masters. The Tournament Organizing Committee (TOC) is seeking a Beer Garden Coordinator to organize a safe and enjoyable venue for alcohol consumption on-site during the tournament.

The Canadian Ultimate Championships Tournament Organizing Committee (CUCTOC) will support key volunteer positions with guidance and resources. The Beer Garden Coordinator will be part of a team of Coordinators, all of whom will be expected to support each other through the planning and execution of CUC. As part of a unified team, volunteers can expect a positive and collaborative work environment where the time, ideas, and opinions of all contributors are respected.

This role is a good fit for someone who enjoys coordinating and supervising (think of it as planning and running your own bar).

This is an exciting opportunity to build skills and experience in the areas of event planning, safety, risk management and logistics coordination

Responsibilities of the Beer Garden Coordinator

- Develop a comprehensive plan for hosting an on-site beer garden that includes requirements for equipment, beverages, volunteers and risk management
- Work with the TOC to obtain proper permitting and insurance for the event
- Work with Sponsorship Director to obtain beer for the event
- Work with the Field Logistics Manager to ensure Beer Garden is properly positioned and secured, and sufficient tables and chairs are in place
- Ensure there is sufficient supply of cups, wristbands and other supplies
- Confirm that all Volunteers are properly trained

Time Commitment

Approximately

- 2 hours per week from March to July
- 10 hours in the week preceding the tournament
- 4-5 hours per day during the tournament
- 2 hours during the week following the tournament

Qualifications

- Must be over 18 years of age
- Demonstrated reliability and organizational ability
- Reliable transportation to and from the main tournament venue
- Experience assessing and mitigating risk is an asset
- Pro-serve certification is an asset

Supervision

The Beer Garden Coordinator reports to the Field Entertainment Coordinator.
